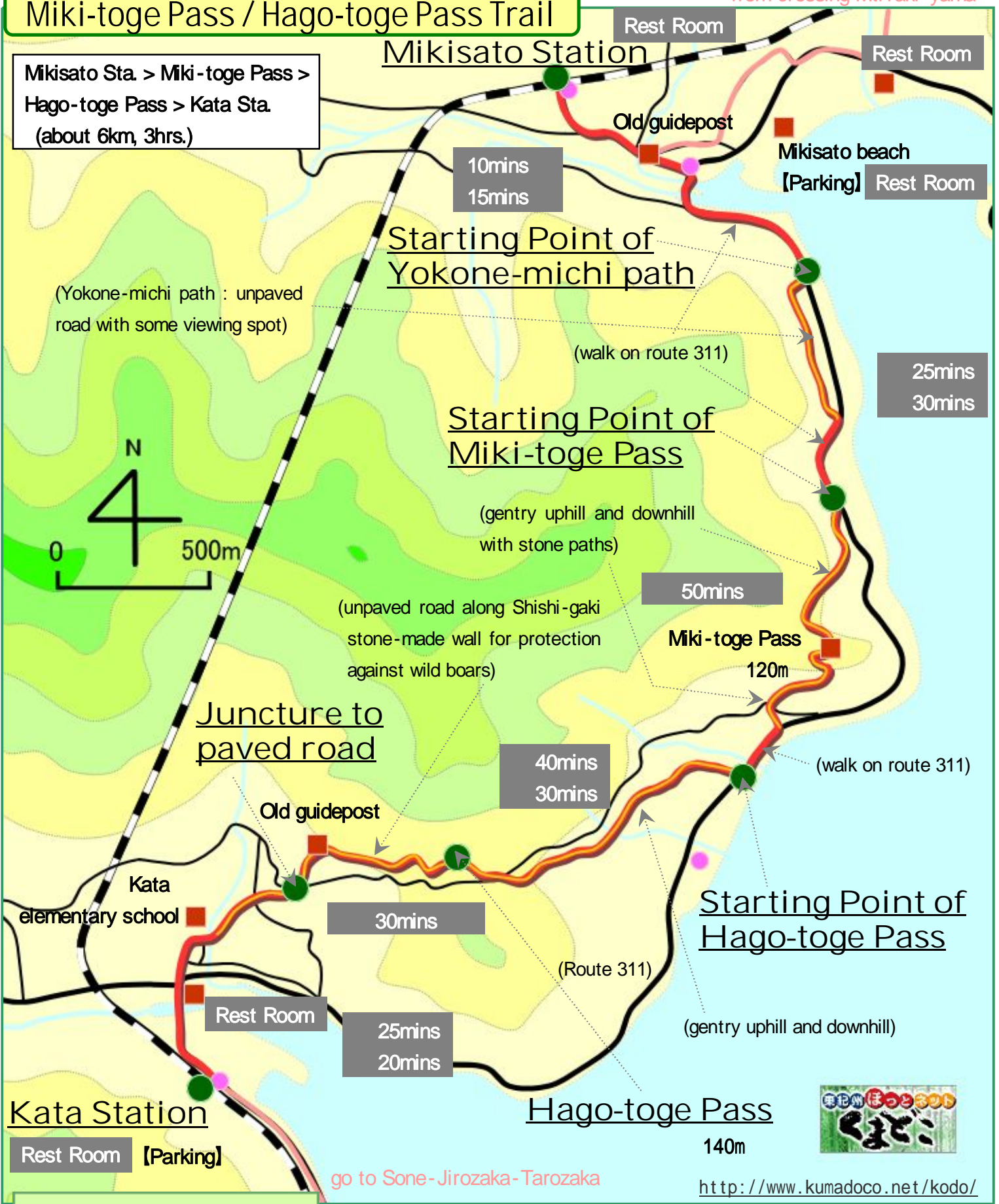


Miki-toge Pass / Hago-toge Pass Trail

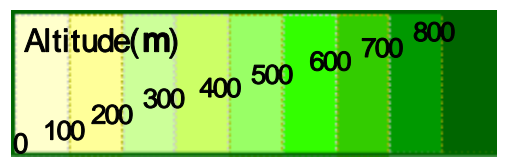
from crossing Mt. Yaki-yama

Summary

Mikisato Station >>>> (slight downhill and uphill, paved road, 15mins.) >>>>

Starting Point of Yokone-michi Path >>>> (unpaved and paved road, 30mins.) >>>>

Starting Point of Miki-toge Pass >> (uphill and downhill, unpaved and paved road, 50mins.) >>

Starting Point of Hago-toge Pass >>>> (mostly downhill, unpaved road, 40mins.) >>>>

Hago-toge Pass >>>> (downhill, unpaved road along Shishi-gaki wall, 30mins.) >>>>

Juncture to paved road >>>> (slightly downhill, paved and unpaved road, 20mins.) >>>>

Transportation

Nagoya Station >> (2hrs. and 25mins. by JR line, Nanki-express) >> **Owase Station** >>
(20mins by JR line, local) >> **Mikisato Station** >> (5mins by JR line, local) >> **Kata Station**

【by car】

Nagoya >> (Highway & Route 42 / 2hrs. and 50mins.) >> **Owase city**

>> (Route 42 / 15mins.) >> **Mikisato Station** >> (Route 311 / 10mins.) >> **Kata Station**
